My name is Anthony J. Windisch. I am a Certified Computing Professional (CCP). And I worked for the federal government from 1982 until 1991.

In the federal government, ACCOUNTANTS have the job "...to implement 'Start of the Art' computer systems..." And I suffered through the failure of three major computer projects. I filed a Whistleblower Complaint about federal "Computer and Financial Mismanagement" in 1992.

My attorney wrote to the General Accountability Office (GAO), who confirmed my Complaint. "ADP MODERNIZATION - Half-Billion Dollar FmHA Effort Lacks Adequate Planning and Oversight..."

And without any personal interaction with me, the Office of Special Counsel (OSC) rejected my Complaint. In 1993 GAO reported, "WHITBLEWOWER PROTECTIONS - Reasons for Whistleblowers'" Dissatisfaction Need To Be Explored..."

In 2000, GAO reported in GAO/T-AIMD-00-181, "...the potential for more catastrophic damage is significant... over 100 countries already have or are developing computer attack capabilities. Hostile nations or terrorists could use cyber-based tools and techniques to disrupt military operations, communication networks, and other information systems or networks..."

And "...As noted in previous testimonies and reports, almost every federal agency has poor computer security. Federal agencies are not only at risk from computer virus attacks, but are also at serious risk of having their key systems and information assets compromised or damaged from both computer hackers as well as unauthorized insiders..."

While GAO continues to report about the mismanagement of our federal government, on October 24, 2014, a GAO attorney wrote in a letter to me, "...However, GAO does not have legal authority to enforce its recommendations..."

On February 25, 2015, I wrote to President Barack Obama. "...YOU HAVE NOT ANSWERED MY PREVIOUS LETTERS!...", nor my FINAL report which I have also mailed to the General Accountability Office (GAO).
